Introduction

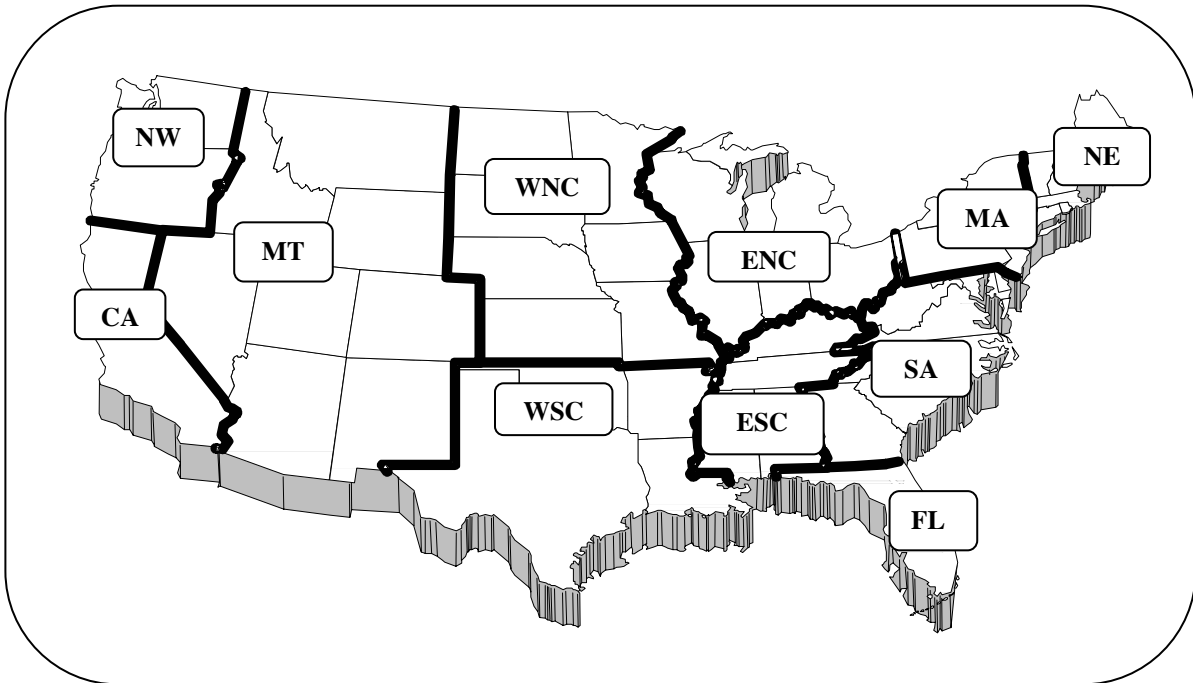
